Authors Guidelines

SUBMISSION OF PAPERS TO JESA: Manuscripts should be sent to: ethstat@gmail.com in MS WORD format. Besides, you can submit through XXX. The submitted article should not be identical or similar to a paper submitted to another journal and should be no longer than 15 pages.

NOTES ON THE PREPARATION OF PAPERS: Here is a summary of some of the important points:

AN ABSTRACT should be included, completely summarizing the paper without repeating verbatim sentences from the paper. In the SUMMARY, mathematical symbols should be avoided and any reference to a previous work should be given in full. Author(s) name should be followed by full postal and E-mail addresses.

REFERENCES in the text should be by the author's surname for foreigners (use the given name for Ethiopians) and the publication date. In publications of three authors, all are listed for the first time, and et al. is used subsequently together with the first surname. An example is: "Moore, Sylvester and Smith (1985)" for the first time and "Moore et al, is used throughout. In the list of the REFERENCES at the end of the paper, authors should be listed alphabetically by last name for foreigners and by first name of Ethiopians. Journal titles should not be abbreviated.

TABLES AND FIGURES should represent only essential materials. They should be placed on separate sheets and identified by Arabic numerals and a short descriptive title. For printing, figures and illustrations may have to be substantially reduced so that lines should be of sufficient thickness, and decimal points, periods and dots should be large enough to be reproduced upon drastic reduction. All figures should be complete with regard to labels, titles, numbering, etc. and ready for printing as they are after any reproduction. The placement of all tables, figures and

illustrations should be marked within the text. The only lines appearing on a table should be horizontal. Very small tables should be incorporated into the text. All decimals and numbers should be aligned in columns.

LAYOUT OF A PAPER

The presentation of research papers frequently follows the following order.

1. ***Title*** in boldface centered at the top of the first page followed by the full name(s) of the author(s) and address (es).
2. ***Abstract*** of the main results of the paper.
3. ***Introduction*** to the background of the research.
4. ***Research Method(s)***.
5. ***Results***.
6. ***Discussion of the Results***.
7. ***Acknowledgments***, if any.
8. ***References***.
9. ***Appendix*** if any.
